



Pillow Cases

	Standard	Queen	King
Base Fabric	3/4 yard	7/8 yard	1 yard
Cuff Fabric	1/3 yard	1/3 yard	1/3 yard
Trim Fabric	1/8 (cut to 1.5 – 2")	1/8 (cut to 1.5 – 2")	1/8 (cut to 1.5 – 2")

Press all fabrics. Open cuff fabric and lay long edge, horizontal, right side up on a flat surface. On top of that, lay the top edge of the main fabric, right side up. Cut your trim fabric to desired width, press in half horizontally; place on top of the other two fabrics, raw edges matching. Roll up the bottom portion of the main fabric until cuff fabric is exposed. Roll the cuff fabric over the main fabric roll and align the raw edges. Pin and stitch with a 1/4" or 1/2" seam. Pull rolled main fabric out of the tube and press. Trim the selvage off as you make the edges of the three fabrics even. With wrong sides together, sew the bottom and open side of the pillowcase with a scant 1/4" seam. Turn inside out and press. Finish the French seam by stitching a generous 1/4" seam over the existing seam.
